



What is involved in obtaining a Advanced Level Practitioner Certificate in Dynamic Assessment practice?

Step 1: **Attend our workshop 'Rethink Learning using Dynamic Assessment'** or ask for previous training to be recognised as commensurate with this workshop. Online workshops are available throughout the year.

Step 2: Apply dynamic assessment in practice and gather evidence of your use of the approach using case studies, group work, classroom observation, and/or delivering training. **Keep a reflective diary of when and how you use DA** (forms are provided for this). Consult the Guide on how to Build Mediated Learning Competencies to assist you. At least 20 hours of DA practice are required for submission. Remember to use the online forum on www.dynamicassessmentuk.com for any questions or queries or advice

Step 3: Attend our regular online 'drop in' sessions for those registered on the certification programme (these take place every 6-8 weeks throughout the year). Engage in our exclusive online forum where practitioners can share ideas, askquestions, and discuss DA in a supportive, friendly environment.

Step 4: Write up a report on 3 pieces of work (they don't all have to be pieces of individual casework) where your use of DA has led to a positive outcome (around 500 words for each piece of work). Write a short report (around 500 words) on how/where you have developed your skills in DA compared to the beginning of the registration period. In total 2000-3000 words.

Step 5: Submit your work to either fraser@dynamicassessment.uk or clare@dynamicassessment.uk for consideration of a BPS approved certificate of Advanced Dynamic Assessment Practice.
